

[Academic Video Online](#) lots of short videos and feature length films (we had a trial last year)

→ added bonus: you can display/search transcript and create excerpt clips

*Searching:* 1) Do a general search from the main page or 2) click on the menu lines, upper left > Channels > All Channels for some useful categories.

*Access:* Library web page ([online](#) or via [SHS Student Commons](#) in Canvas) > Databases & eBooks > [Film & Video Databases](#) > Academic Video Online

If needed, username: skyline password: spartans

[Ancestry.com](#) - access to all original and primary documents in Ancestry's genealogy collections (*note: only accessible from school*)

→ searches census, military, other public records – marriage, passenger lists, etc. [*example, [Sidney Poitier's draft card](#)*]

→ for American history mostly or students searching for people/family that has been in the U.S. for a couple generations

→ Also gives you access to [Fold3](#) (U.S. military records [*example [Daves Enrollment Cards](#)*]) and [Newspapers.com](#) (U.S. newspaper archives – general searches or search by state and year [*example, Birmingham's [Voice of the People, April 1919](#)*])

### [Gale Databases](#)

→ we had much of this access last year via KCLS, but now it is back through the Puget Sound ESD, not that that matters – but now students should have direct access from school and will be required to login only from home

→ current password is Issaquah411! – but have asked for a change to spartans – the passwords page will reflect that when it's made

[Indigenous Peoples of North America](#) – primary sources exploring “political, social, and cultural history of native peoples from the sixteenth century well into the twentieth century”

→ *Searching:* 1) Do a general search or 2) take a look at the '[Collections](#)' option, upper right (you might need to come back to this link if you have just logged into KCLS – it is a weird glitch)

→ *Access:* via KCLS (if you don't have a library card, the teacher access directions are attached, or you can use this temp. access: Barcode: 4110052 Password: 0052)
