

THE ORAL PRESENTATION

Non-Testers have two options

- Pre-recorded video presentation (due 3/1)
 - record your own analysis and turn in
 - •5-7 minutes

- Formal written analysis (due 3/1)
 - researched, 4-5 pages (1,200 words, give or take a 100)

Pre-recorded Video Presentation

- Due Wednesday, March 1
- Turn in via link to online video, USB, dvd...
- Presentation is to be 5-7 minutes
 - give or take 10 seconds; any more than that and you will lose points
- You may use brief notes (ie: note card, brief list...)
 - You may NOT read from a prepared document and any notes should be used for reference and guidance only
- You must reference at least three sources in your presentation
 - "according to Robert Smith from UCLA..."
 - "In Robert Smith's book Film History..."
- While you must submit a video, you are being graded just on your oral presentation – just be sure you can be seen and that the audio/sound is clear.

Formal Written Analysis

- Due to turnitin on Wednesday, 3/1
- **4-5 page paper** (1,200 words, give or take a 100)
- MLA format (heading, font, spacing, margins, title)
- It is a formal essay (no "I think", "you can see", etc.) and while this isn't a thesis driven paper, for organization, you may want to make an overall statement that guides your analysis
- Cite at least 3 sources must be academic sources and at least one book
