1) Go to [iCheck Movies](#) and sign up

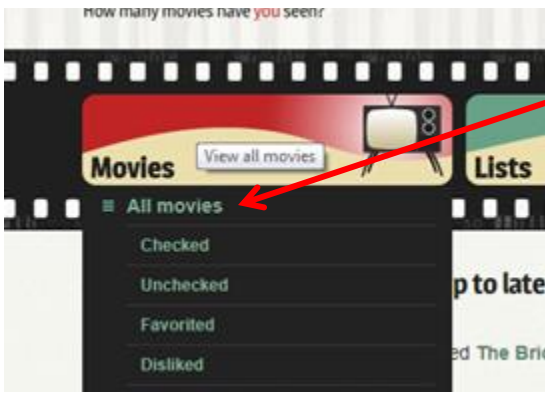
2) Choose the FREE option

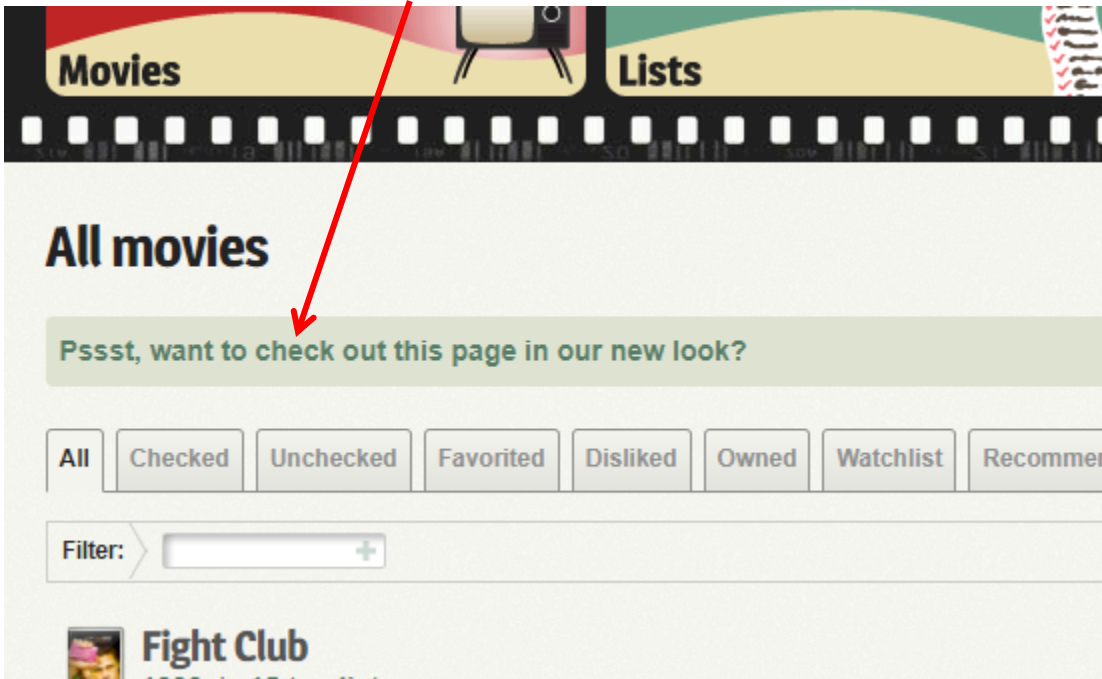
3) Register:

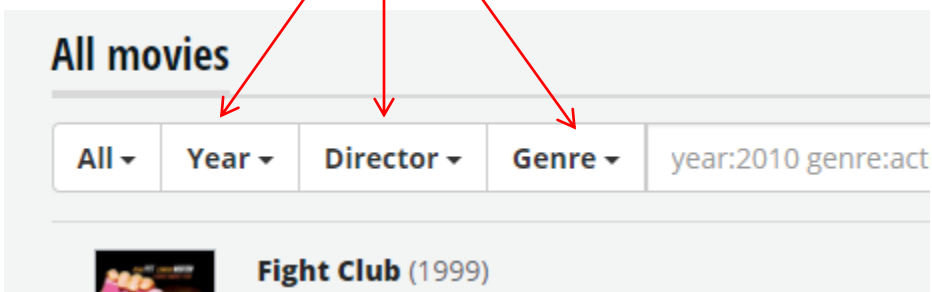
4) Start marking your watched movies by clicking on “All Movies”



5) Then click on the green link for a user-friendly list...

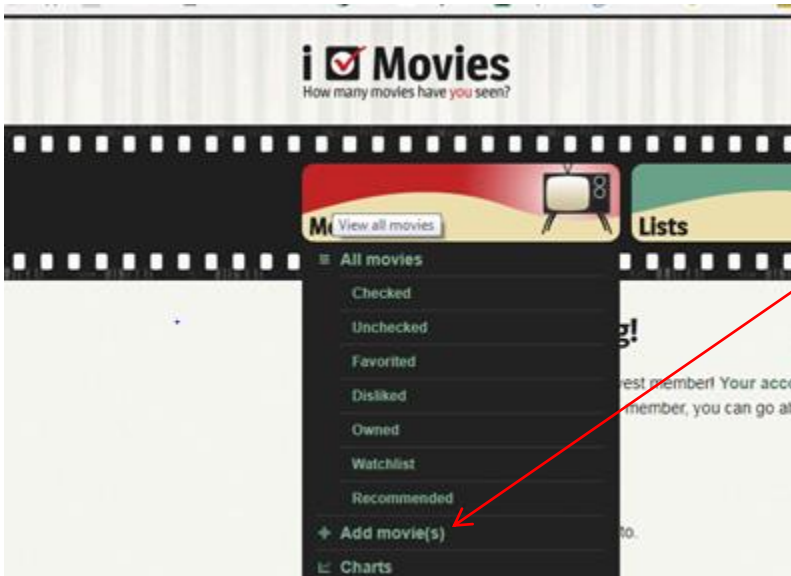


6) Click on some of the drop-down lists to get some of you familiar movie titles.
