View *The Artist* on your own if you are unable able to stay after school to watch it in the theater round. The movie needs to be viewed in full before school begins on Wednesday, October 4th.

You must do one of two things to fulfill this alternate way of viewing the movie.

Either

1) Watch the movie in its entirety in one sitting without doing anything else (no phone, computer, conversations, etc...). Think theater-like: try to watch it on a tv vs. your computer/tablet/iPad to make it more of an event. If you do this, all you need to do is write a note to this effect: that you focused on the movie and did nothing else while watching *The Artist*.

- I have not tried this option before; please be honest, I am trusting you.

Or

2) If you are unable to watch the movie in one sitting and/or you are too busy to completely focus on the movie (it happens!), please address these two questions (each requires a two/three sentence answer – this isn't meant as a penalty, but so you are able to focus a little more on the movie).

1) Use some film/cinematic language to describe one particular scene.

2) Did you like the movie? Explain some.

Whichever option you choose, it is due to turnitin before school begins on Wednesday, October 4th.

For some reason, you will need to register again in **TurnItIn** for IB Film, sorry.
